Classes at **Wisdom Business School Free Zone Campus** are scheduled in such a way as to ensure that students pursue **ACCA course also along with their graduation**. As a few papers of both the courses are similar in content, it will be a support to the students to achieve better results in both the examinations. After completing **ACCA** (Fundamentals Level) along with BBA or BCom Degree, students can continue their regular MBA/MCom program at WBS, with the option to prepare for the ACCA Professional Level examination. Thus, they will be able to complete a professional Course, i.e. ACCA, along with their postgraduation, which will greatly enhance their employability.

The ACCA coaching will be provided at WBS along with the BCom/BBA course. Students who are not able to continue their course at Wisdom Business School after graduation, can join any other branch of Wisdom (Dubai, Sharjah or Abu Dhabi) to complete their ACCA Final Part (Professional Level).

Certifications

Students will be awarded "**Diploma in Accounting and Business**" after successful completion of first three papers (F1,F2,F3) along with Foundations in Professionalism (online Interactive module). They will be awarded "**Advanced Diploma in Accounting and Business**" after successful completion of all the nine papers (F1 – F9) along with Professional Ethics module.

Route to ACCA Qualification

What is ACCA?

The Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) is one of world's leading professional-accountancy organizations, with nearly 450,000 members and student members spanning 170 countries. ACCA members are employed in public practice, industry, commerce and private sector.

How do I become ACCA qualified?

In order to qualify, one must complete the 3 elements required by ACCA – Exams, Ethics and Experience.

Exams

Students are required to complete 2 levels – Fundamentals and Professional. These 2 levels comprise 16 papers, 14 of which they are required to pass (unless they obtain exemption for any of the papers).



1. Fundamentals Level – Knowledge & Skills Module

The Fundamentals Level is divided into two modules-- Knowledge and Skills. The Knowledge module introduces you to the main areas of financial and management accounting. You will study the other technical accountancy-areas after this. There are six subjects in the Skills module which cover the main technical areas that accountants are expected to know.

2. Professional Level – Essentials and Options Module

The Professional Level is divided into two modules – Essentials and Options. Both the modules have been set at the same ability level as a Masters degree. At this level, you are expected to apply knowledge, skills and professional judgment as well as analyze, evaluate and make recommendations. You are not required to take all papers at one sitting.

Ethics

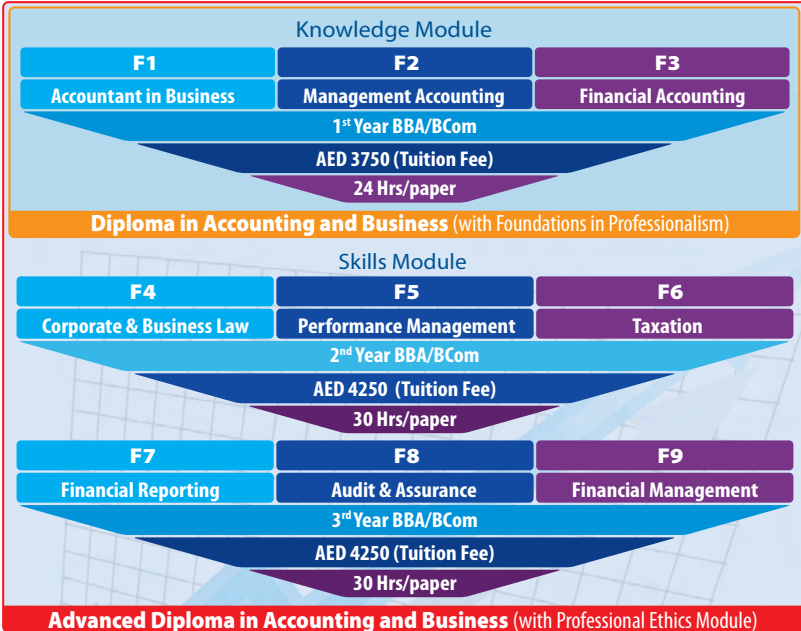
It's important you know what it means to act professionally and ethically. All the students have to take the Foundations in Professionalism online interactive module to achieve any of the Foundation level awards and the Diploma in Accounting and Business as part of the ACCA qualification; and the Professional Ethics module to achieve the Advanced Diploma and the ACCA Qualification.

Experience

You must have 3 years' relevant practical experience, which can be obtained before, during or after your exams. This is known as Practical Experience Requirement (PER). You will be asked to provide ACCA with an online annual return to show the experience you have gained during the preceding year, which has to be authorized by a workplace mentor. If you have completed your Exams and Ethics module, but not your Experience requirements, you will be designated as an ACCA Affiliate. Once you have completed all the three elements, you can apply to ACCA for full membership and have 'ACCA' after your name.

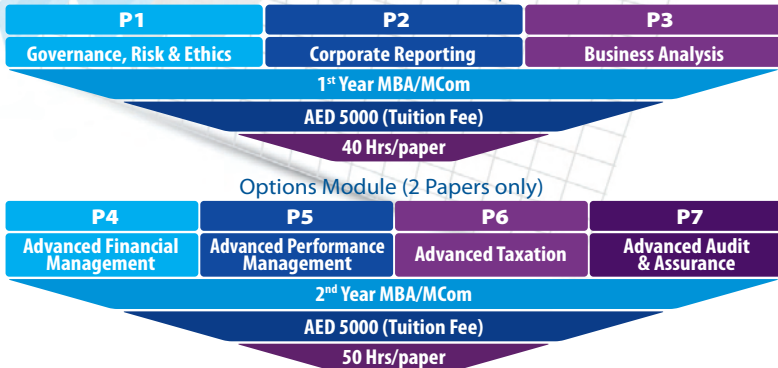
Course Structure
